Korean Air implemented Ramco Aviation across its Engine Maintenance Center, integrating engine maintenance, finance, customer support, billing, warehouse management, and ecosystem interfaces within a unified platform. The solution has improved operational visibility, streamlined maintenance workflows, and strengthened collaboration across engineering functions. The rollout has enabled digital capture of technical issues both in flight and on the ground, with real-time connectivity to the airline's maintenance and engineering system supporting maintenance on arrival and closer collaboration between cockpit and maintenance teams.
